IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE, YOU MUST LIVE IN CHARLOTTE or ATTEND THE LEADERSHIP ACADEMY (formerly Charlotte High School)!

The applicant should submit a scholastic transcript, including recent grades and PSAT, SAT OR ACT scores. In addition, two (2) letters of recommendation (preferably from a counselor, teacher, principal or community member) MUST be submitted. The applicant must submit a short essay of 100 words or less on his/her career goals and what influenced their choice.

PLEASE BE SURE TO FILL OUT THE ENTIRE APPLICATION AND SUBMIT WITH TRANSCRIPT, ESSAY AND REFERENCE LETTERS BY JUNE 4, 2017 ANY APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED WITHOUT SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS OR MISSING INFORMATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
