

Community Development Committee Update – June 2018 (by Sue Roethel)

Port of Rochester & Charlotte Community Vision Plan in Development

The CCA's Community Development Committee is creating a new long-term vision plan for Charlotte. It will become the blueprint to show the City and potential developers what the community wants for the future of the Port and surrounding areas. The committee has been meeting twice monthly since March and working with graduate students from an Urban and Regional Planning class from RIT's Architecture program. An analysis of the results from the community design charrette that happened in November 2017 is almost completed. The next steps are to select the most desirable ideas to pursue, map them out visually and investigate the feasibility. The Committee hopes to present the new vision plan to the community in the fall.
