Rochester Police Department (RPD) – Officer Blanchard, Officer NSC

 - One break in and one robbery.
- Security classes were offered at the Towers regarding identity theft
- Memorial Day is in planning. Lt. Dearcop will report next month.
- Community Outreach is scheduled for July 18 at the beach pavilion.
- Question from the floor: Will the sheriff be reporting. No, they are not in attendance. Interest in a drug overdose over the weekend. RPD was able to respond that the subject was being treated not charged. If you have further questions please call the main number 425-7620.
- Question from floor regarding RPD manpower assignment in the area. Deployment is based on calls for service and is reviewed and changed as needed.

Rochester Fire Department (RFD) Engine 19 - Capt. Scott Daily
