CITY OF ROCHESTER UPDATES

Rochester Police Department (RPD) – Lt. Rick Waldo

- In the month of September there were no assaults, 2 robberies, 2 burglaries, no car break ins or theft.
- The community is still concerned with activity at the gas station corner of Lake and Denise. Can the lights be brought back? What other remedies might be helpful. Capt. Dearcop and Lt. Waldo noted the owner has always been cooperative with police.
 - A member of the audience suggested that just walking by and even going into the store to introduce ourselves, we might help to deter any activity around the station.

Rochester Fire Department (RFD) Lt. Daily

- RFD offered no report but did respond to questions.
 - One member questioned why some of the marker poles have been removed from fire hydrants. They are being replaced with bendable poles that make it easier for firemen to use the hydrants.
 - Another question about activities around fire prevention week. Visiting schools and helping with fire drills.

Northwest Neighborhood Service Center (NSC) - No Report

City Council NW Representative – Molly Clifford

- Molly's final coffee in Charlotte will be on October 12.
- RCSD audit has found a 30-million-dollar deficit. This may impact the city's credit rating. State has sent investigators.

Zina Logonegro, City of Rochester Manager of Zoning

- A plan is being presented to City Council to change the way that entertainment licenses are handled. It will also clarify the definition of entertainment and some of the responsibilities surrounding enforcement.
