CITY OF ROCHESTER UPDATES

Rochester Police Department (RPD) – Lt. Ratke from NSC

- There was a reported Carjacking on January 12. The victim subsequently convinced a bystander to follow the car. Further investigation showed that all parties were acquainted.
- On January 25 Tropix had event. There were six uniformed officers present at closing. Shots were fired in the parking lot, shooter was apprehended. It should be noted that Tropix is cooperating fully and, had 40 private security people on staff that night.
