The applicant must submit a <u>short</u> <u>essay of 100 words or less</u> on his/her career goals and what influenced their choice.

Deadline: The entire application and attachments (transcript, essay and reference letters) must be submitted by **June 30, 2020**. Any applications received without supporting documents or missing information will not be accepted.
