Instructions for the Charlotte Community Association and Edward Watson Memorial Scholarship

Application

The Charlotte Community Association (CCA) is pleased to announce that two scholarships will be awarded to college; trade/technical/vocational school bound students who are residents of the Charlotte community or attend the Northeast College Preparatory High School(formerly Charlotte High School). The CCA will award one \$2,000 award which is made possible through community fundraising and membership donations. Another award of \$2,000 is provided by a fund created in memory of Edward Watson, a Charlotte resident and former Charlotte High student.
