Instructions for the Edward Watson Memorial Community Scholarship

The Charlotte Community Association (CCA) is pleased to facilitate in the distribution of two scholarships of \$1,000 each to be awarded to two college; trade/technical/vocational school bound students who attend **any** area high school. These two \$1,000 scholarships are made possible by a separate fund created in memory of Edward Watson, a Charlotte resident and former Charlotte High student.

Eligibility: For the **Edward Watson Memorial Community Scholarships**, a college, trade/technical/vocational school bound high school senior can attend **any** area high school and **must** reside in the **Charlotte Community**, which extends to the beginning of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery to the south and the town of Greece borders and the town of Irondequoit borders.

Requirements: Each applicant <u>must</u> submit a scholastic transcript, including recent grades. In addition, <u>two</u> (2) letters of recommendation (preferably from a counselor, teacher, principal or community member) <u>must</u> be submitted. The applicant also <u>must</u> submit a <u>short essay of 100 words or less</u> on his/her career goals and what influenced their choice.

Deadline: The entire application and attachments (transcript, essay and reference letters) <u>must</u> be submitted by **June 30, 2025** Any applications received without supporting documents or missing information <u>will not</u> be accepted.
